(HONS) Subjects : Physics , Chemistry, Mathematics ,Botany, Zoology, Physiology, Economics, Nutrition, Electronics, Anthropology, Micro-Biology, Computer Science ,Bio-Technology ,Geography , Statistics, Geology.
